- It will be your job to take your group to the above mentioned events and to be with them during the trips and other activities. It goes without saying that you will not only be present but you will actively entertain the group.

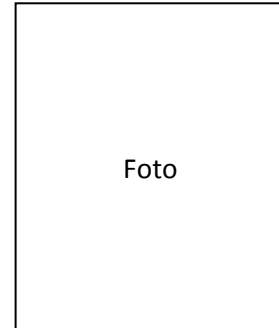
